About Škofja Loka

The picturesque Škofja Loka, proudly standing at the confluence of Poljanska and Selška Sora rivers at the crossing of Sorško polje field into the diverse world of the hills of Škofja Loka and Polhov Gradec, is the best preserved medieval town in Slovenia and the economic, cultural, educational and administrative centre of the Škofja Loka municipality. The excellent position on the confluence of two rivers and on crossroads of traffic and trade routes - only 22 kilometres from Ljubljana Capital and 20 kilometres from Ljubljana Airport - has encouraged the development of craft and enterprise.

Nowadays, around 23.000 inhabitants live in Škofja Loka municipality. There is a strong and propulsive cast and machine industry as well as growing food production. Škofja Loka has a great potential for development culture, history based tourism and outdoor sport activities in nearby green and well-preserved countryside.

Škofja Loka has rich cultural heritage. Romuald Marušič, Capuchin monk from Škofja Loka, wrote the Passion Play of Škofja Loka in 1721. That manuscript is the oldest preserved drama text written in Slovene language. Sublime procession, which happens every 6 years in the streets of ancient town, is going to be performed again in 2021 by more than 800 performers and 80 horses. This exceptional performance is inscribed into the UNESCO Representative List of Intangible Cultural Heritage of Humanity.

Škofja Loka has also a long and rich history in the field of civil society organisations that range from cultural and sport to touristic and historical associations as well as different leisure interests and educational opportunities.

About the project - "Juniors for seniors – active ageing"

Municipality Škofja Loka – as a leading partner - together with 11 partner municipalities applied for an international project EUROPE FOR CITIZENS – "Juniors for seniors – active ageing".

Within this network of 12 towns, the project aims at advancing the discussion on the future of Europe with a special focus on the topic of Europe's aging population and the issues arising from this. The project will address the Euroscepticism among seniors and will look into the possibilities for more active engagement and intergenerational activities.

The main activities of this project consist of 6 events, which will take place in 4 partner towns according to the following schedule:

- Škofja Loka, Slovenia (26.9. – 28.9.2019);
- Škofja Loka, Slovenia (3.9. – 5.9.2020);
- Judenburg, Austria (March 2021);
- Škofja Loka, Slovenia (6. – 9.5.2021);
- Kőszeg, Hungary (26. – 28.8.2021);
- Bad Kötzting, Germany (October 2021).

Due to the Corona-virus pandemic the participants will come from the partner's towns and will be present on the event, some of them will be present through video connection. They will be invited to be connected directly on the system and will get detail instruction about.

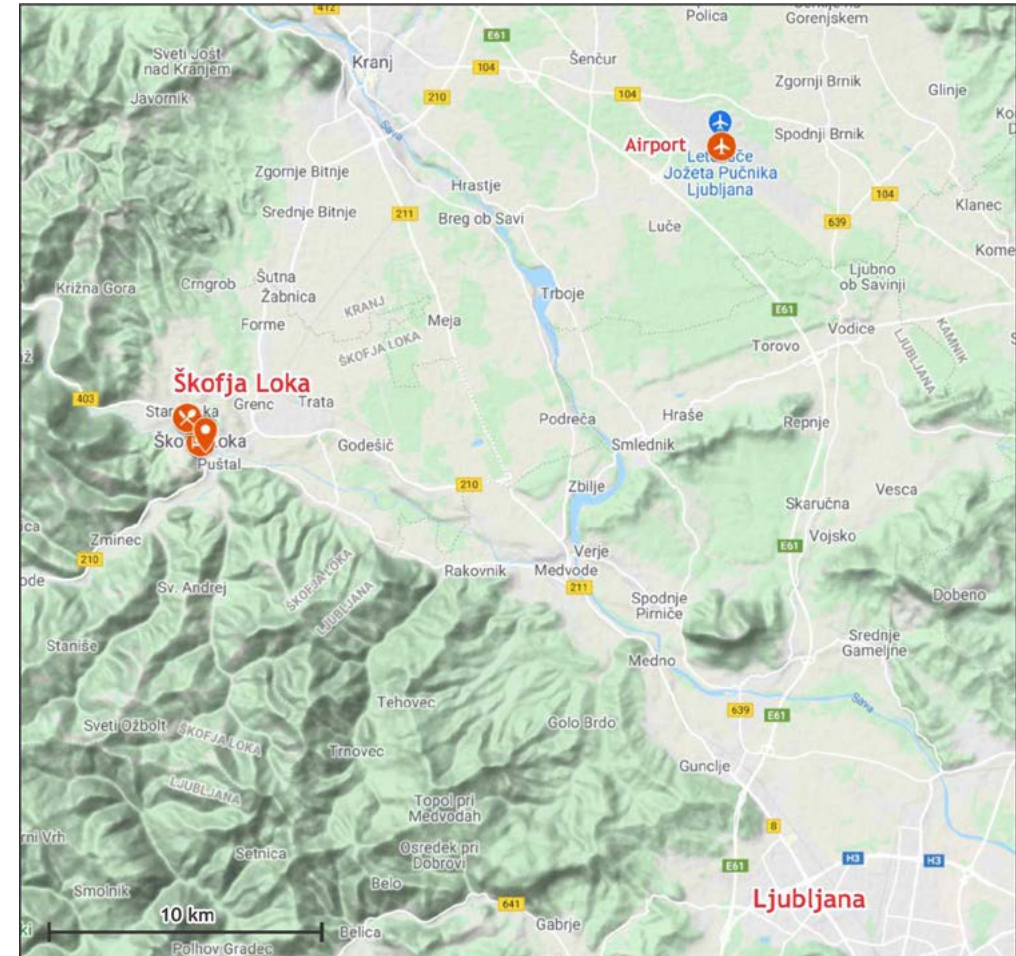

The guests will be accommodated in two small hotels. The map with the hotels can be found on the next page.

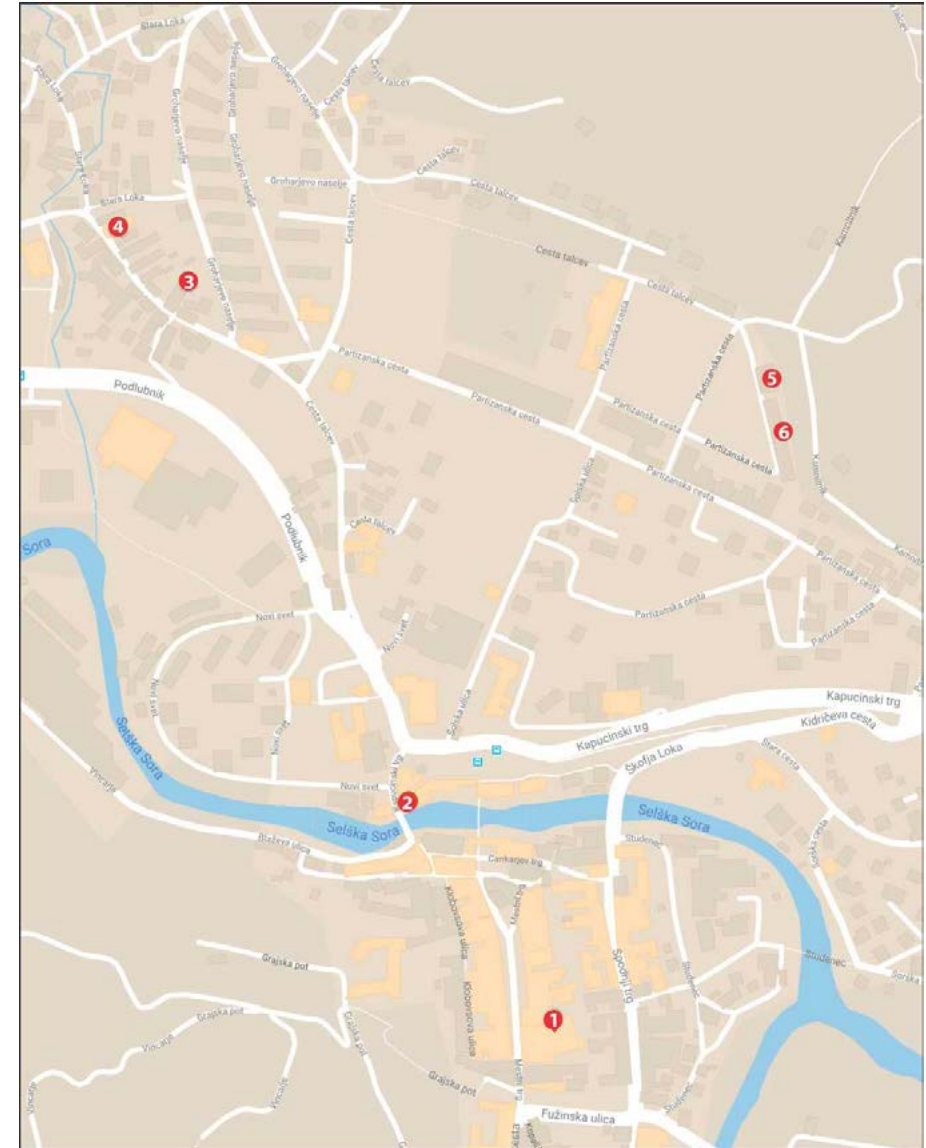
Guests will stay in the following hotels:

Transport in Škofja Loka

Arriving by plane

Škofja Loka is situated 18 kilometres from the Ljubljana Airport. There will be transport organized from the airport to Škofja Loka. There will be a driver waiting with the sign “**Europe for Citizens Škofja Loka**” in the arrival hall. He will wait you at the Ljubljana airport at the time of landing your plane.

Organisers will also arrange the transport from Škofja Loka to the airport on Sunday.

Arriving by car

We suggest that you drive to your hotel and check-in on the arrival day. Both hotels are near the old town centre and you could reach all places on foot.

Useful information

Food and water

You will be served with some typical Slovenian dishes for lunch and dinner.

The center of Škofja Loka offers several bars and pubs, where you can taste local drinks. There are also sweet shops with cakes and ice cream.

Tap water in Škofja Loka (as in Slovenia) is of good quality and suitable for drinking.

Public transport

The local bus in Škofja Loka costs 0,50 EUR for one-way trip.

Škofja Loka has good public transport connections with the capital of Slovenia Ljubljana as well as the capital of Gorenjska region Kranj. You can reach them by bus or train.
